



Henry Alleyne NICHOLSON  
(1844-1899)

Professor of Natural History: Toronto; Newcastle; St. Andrews; Aberdeen;  
one of the most prolific palaeozoologists of the late Nineteenth century.  
A firm believer in the use of zoology for interpreting fossils and he  
greatly influenced the acceptance of microscopic examination of thin  
sections for determining fossil corals, bryozoa and stromatoporoids.
