

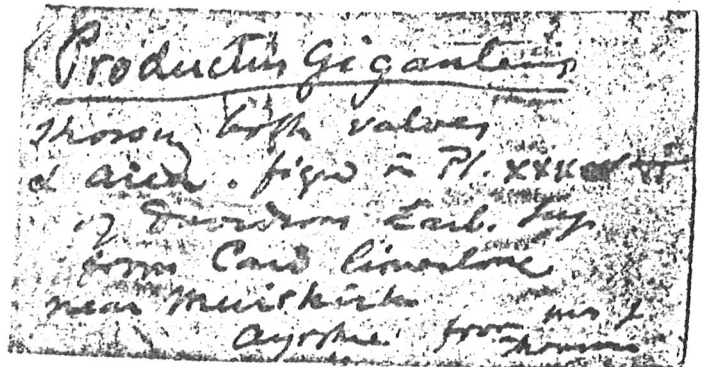
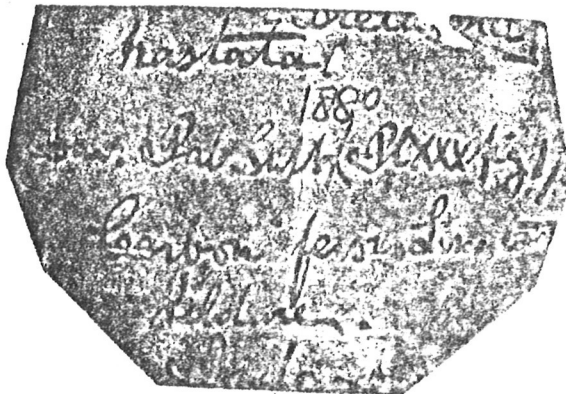


Thomas DAVIDSON

( 17 May 1847 - 14 Oct. 1885 )

Private means enabled Davidson to devote his life to the study of the Brachiopoda after initial encouragement by Von Buch. His artistic studies and abilities were utilised in achieving the significant monographs he published.

Davidson bequeathed his collection, library and Ms notes to the B.M.(N.H.) in 1886.
